To answer charges of being responsible for the following crimes:

- Aiding and abetting rape and sexual assault
- Aiding and abetting sexual abuse of children and other vulnerable persons
- Perverting the course of justice
- Acting as an accessory to the terrorism of rape and domestic violence
- Criminal Negligence
- Sex Discrimination
- Race Discrimination
- Disability Discrimination
- Wasting police time
- Wasting survivors' time and emotional resources, forcing them to investigate rape themselves when the police have not done their job
- Putting the wrong charges
- Dropping cases of rape which should have gone to court for a jury to decide on
- Refusal to present a strong case for the CPS to consider
- Mental cruelty
- Cruelty to children
- Misappropriation of public funds
- Breach of your duty to protect the public
- In response to complaints about injustice, protecting the careers and 'reputation' of police officers instead.
